MARCELLE REVIVE YOUR HOME CONTEST RULES

THE MARCELLE REVIVE YOUR HOME CONTEST (THE "CONTEST") IS INTENDED TO BE CONDUCTED IN CANADA ONLY (EXCLUDING QUEBEC) AND SHALL BE CONSTRUED AND EVALUATED ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE CANADIAN LAW. NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY. PARTICIPANTS MUST BE OF THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THEIR PROVINCE OR TERRITORY OF RESIDENCE OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONTEST RULES (THE "CONTEST RULES").

1. ELIGIBILITY. To be eligible for this Contest, an individual must:

- (a) be a legal resident of Canada (excluding the province of Quebec);
- (b) be of the age of majority in his/her province or territory of residence or older at the time of entry; and
- (c) own a home or property or have the ability and required permissions to renovate your place of residence.

Employees of Corus Sales Inc. its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (collectively "Corus") and Groupe Marcelle Inc. its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (collectively, the "Sponsors"), Jala Communications, advertising and promotional agencies, any person who has been confirmed as a winner of two (2) Corus administered contests within six (6) months preceding the Contest start date indicated below and/or the household members of any of the above are not eligible to enter.

The Sponsors shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to the Sponsors for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.

2. CONTEST PERIOD. The Contest begins at 12:00a.m. Eastern Standard Time ("EST") on March 19, 2018 and ends at 11:59p.m. EST on April 15, 2018 (the "Contest Period") after which time the Contest will be closed and no further entries shall be accepted.

3. HOW TO ENTER.

- (a) There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. Enter using the method of entry outlined below. No entries will be accepted by any other means.
 - (i) To enter online, complete and submit the entry form located at www.hgtv.ca/marcelle (the "Contest Website").
- (b) Limit of one (1) entry per person, per e-mail address per 24-hour period. In the case of multiple entries, only the first eligible entry will be considered.

- (c) All entries become the sole property of the Sponsors and will not be returned for any reason. Entries must be received no later than the end of the Contest Period. Entries will be declared invalid if they are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, irregular, mutilated, forged, garbled or mechanically or electronically reproduced. Unless otherwise set out herein, no communication or correspondence will be exchanged with entrants except with those selected as a potential winner.
- (d) Entries received online shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the entry. For the purpose of the Contest Rules, "authorized account holder" of an e-mail address is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, on-line service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. Any entrant may be required to provide the Sponsors with proof that they are the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with their entry.

4. PRIZES.

- (a) **Grand Prize.** There is one (1) grand prize (the "**Grand Prize**") available to be won by the Grand Prize winner (the "**Grand Prize Winner**") which includes:
 - (i) Ten Thousand Canadian Dollars (CDN\$10,000) to be used towards renovating a space in the Grand Prize Winner's home or place of residence;
 - (ii) A one (1) hour recorded skype décor consultation with Sarah Richardson to discuss design tips for one (1) space in the Grand Prize Winner's home or place of residence; and
 - (iii) One (1), Two Thousand Canadian Dollar (CDN\$2,000) gift card to be used for purchases on www.marcelle.com.
- (b) The Grand Prize has an approximate value of Twenty Thousand Canadian Dollars (CDN\$20,000).
- (c) **Secondary Prizes.** There are thirty (30) secondary prizes (collectively the "**Secondary Prizes**" each, a "**Secondary Prize**") available to be won by the Secondary Prize winners (the "**Secondary Prize Winner**"), each of which consists of:
 - (i) One (1), Marcelle Revival + Skin Renewal Deluxe Kit.
- (d) Each Secondary Prize has an approximate retail value One Hundred Canadian Dollars (CDN\$100).
- (e) Grand Prize and Secondary Prizes are hereafter collectively referred to as "Prize" or "Prizes". Grand Prize Winner and Secondary Prize Winners are hereafter collectively referred to as a "Winner" or "Winners".
- (f) Winners are not entitled to monetary difference between actual Prize value and stated approximate Prize value, if any.
- (g) The Sponsors and/or the Sponsors' representatives will contact the Winners to coordinate

the provision of the Prizes within thirty (30) days once such Winners have been successfully contacted and notified of his/her Prize and fulfilled the requirements set out herein.

5. PRIZE CONDITIONS.

- (a) Winners will be responsible for any other expense not explicitly included in the Prizes.
- (b) Grand Prize Winner must be available to participate in the consultation with Sarah Richardson before December 15, 2018 and will be required to send questions, specifications and photographs of the space to be renovated prior to the consultation and as directed by the Sponsors. If the Grand Prize Winner is unable to participate in the consultation, the Grand Prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.
- (c) Grand Prize Winner shall not acquire any rights in and to the skype décor consultation recording, except for a limited license for personal use, nor shall the Grand Prize Winner reproduce, which includes taking photographs or recording by any means, the skype décor consultation with Sarah Richardson. The Grand Prize Winner shall have no right to use any image or any other attributes of Sarah Richardson and has no right to publish or render public the skype décor consultation recording provided to the Grand Prize Winner.
- (d) Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, assigned, substituted or redeemed for cash, except at the sole discretion of the Sponsors. Any unused, unclaimed or declined portion of a Prize will be forfeited, have no cash value and the Sponsors shall have no obligation to provide either an alternative or value-in-kind. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if a Prize (or any portion thereof) cannot be awarded for any reason.
- (e) Shipped Prizes shall not be insured and the Sponsors shall not assume any liability for lost, damaged or misdirected Prizes.

6. WINNER SELECTION.

Thirty-One (31) Winners shall be selected as follows:

- (a) On or about April 18, 2018 in Toronto, Ontario, thirty-one (31) entrants will be selected by a random draw from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period (for greater clarity, one (1) selected entrant shall be the Grand Prize Winner and thirty (30) selected entrants shall be the Secondary Prize Winners). Each entrant shall be eligible to win only one (1) Prize. The odds of being selected as a potential winner are dependent upon the number of eligible entries received by the Sponsors. Before being declared a Winner, the selected entrant shall be required to correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question to be administered during a pre-arranged telephone call or by e-mail, to comply with the Contest Rules and sign and return the Release (described below).
- (b) EACH SELECTED ENTRANT WILL BE NOTIFIED BY TELEPHONE NO LATER THAN APRIL 30, 2018 AT 5:00P.M. AND MUST RESPOND WITHIN TWO (2) BUSINESS DAYS OF NOTIFICATION. Upon notification, the selected entrant must respond by telephone or e-mail (as specified in the notification) to the contact number or e-mail address provided no later than the indicated deadline set out in the Contest Rules

and/or the notification. If the selected entrant does not respond accordingly, he/she will be disqualified and will not receive a Prize and another entrant may be selected in the Sponsors' sole discretion until such time as an entrant satisfies the terms set out herein. The Sponsors are not responsible for the failure for any reason whatsoever of a selected entrant to receive notification or for the Sponsors to receive a selected entrant's response.

- (c) If, as a result of an error relating to the entry process, drawing or any other aspect of the Contest, there are more selected entrants than contemplated in these Contest Rules, there will be a random draw amongst all eligible Prize claimants after the Contest's closing date to award the correct number of Prizes.
7. **RELEASE.** Winner will be required to execute a legal agreement and release ("**Release**") that confirms Winners': (i) eligibility for the Contest and compliance with these Contest Rules; (ii) acceptance of the Prize as offered; (iii) release of each of the Sponsors and their respective parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates and/or related companies and each of their employees, directors, officers, suppliers, agents, sponsors, administrators, licensees, representatives, advertising, media buying and promotional agencies (collectively, the "**Releasees**") from any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, cost or expense arising out of participation in the Contest, participation in any Contest-related activity or the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize, including but not limited to costs, injuries, losses related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation, or portrayal in a false light, or from any and all claims of third parties arising therefrom; and (iv) grant to the Sponsors of the unrestricted right, in the Sponsors' collective or individual discretion, to produce, reproduce, display, publish, convert, post, serve, broadcast, communicate by telecommunication, exhibit, distribute, adapt and otherwise use or re-use the Winner's name, statements, image, likeness, voice and biography, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, in connection with the Contest and the promotion and exploitation thereof. The executed Release must be returned within two (2) business days of the date indicated on the accompanying letter of notification or the verification as a Winner or the selected entrant will be disqualified and the Prize forfeited.
8. **INDEMNIFICATION BY ENTRANT.** By entering the Contest, each entrant releases, indemnifies and holds Releasees harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from (a) their participation in the Contest or any Contest-related activity; (b) the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize; or (c) any breach of the Contest Rules. Each entrant agrees to fully indemnify Releasees from any and all claims by third parties relating to the entrant's participation in the Contest, without limitation.
9. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.** The Sponsors assume no responsibility or liability for lost, late, unintelligible/illegible, falsified, damaged, misdirected or incomplete entries, notifications, responses, replies or any Release, or for any computer, online, software, telephone, hardware or technical malfunctions that may occur, including but not limited to malfunctions that may affect the transmission or non-transmission of an entry. The Sponsors are not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest. The Sponsors assume no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries. The Sponsors assume no responsibility or liability in the event that the Contest cannot be

conducted as planned for any reason, including those reasons beyond the control of the Sponsors, such as infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or corruption of the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Contest, and/or the Contest Website.

- 10. CONDUCT.** By participating in the Contest, each entrant is deemed to have executed and agrees to be bound by the Contest Rules, which will be posted at the Contest Website and made available throughout the Contest Period. Entrant further agrees to be bound by the decisions of the Sponsors, which shall be final and binding in all respects. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant found to be: (a) violating the Contest Rules; (b) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Contest, and/or the Contest Website or any related promotional website; (c) violating the terms of service, conditions of use and/or general rules or guidelines of any Corus Entertainment Inc. property or service; and/or (d) acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass the Sponsors or any other person. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE THE CONTEST WEBSITE OR ANY RELATED WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST MAY BE A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS. - (b) By opting-in online you consent to Corus’ disclosure of your Personal Information to Groupe Marcelle Inc. so that you may be contacted to promote opportunities and to receive newsletters about Group Marcelle Inc.’s products. Groupe Marcelle Inc. will use the entrant’s Personal Information only for identified purposes, and protect the entrant’s Personal Information in a manner that is consistent with Groupe Marcelle Inc.’s Privacy Policy at: <https://www.marcelle.com/en/privacy-statement/>.
- (c) By opting-in online you consent to Corus Sales Inc. and any of its corporate affiliate’s use of your Personal Information to subscribe you to the HGTV newsletter. Corus will use the entrant’s Personal Information only for identified purposes, and protect the entrant’s Personal Information in a manner that is consistent with Corus’ Privacy Policy at: <http://www.corusent.com/privacy-policy/>.

13. **TERMINATION.** The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to terminate the Contest, in whole or in part, and/or modify, amend or suspend the Contest, and/or the Contest Rules in any way, at any time, for any reason without prior notice.
14. **LAW.** These are the official Contest Rules. The Contest is subject to applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The Contest Rules are subject to change without notice in order to comply with any applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws or the policy of any other entity having jurisdiction over the Sponsors. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Contest Rules or the rights and obligations as between the entrant and the Sponsors in connection with the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of Ontario without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other jurisdiction's laws.
